One font lets you create 2-letter monograms in a unique retro-future style. There are several options included so you can experiment with your particular monogram.

1. Install the font like any other. Unsure how? Google "install fonts in [my operating system.]" After installing, restart the application you want to work in.

2. Type the large letter using the uppercase keys (A-Z). Follow the keystrokes in red at right to create the monogram as seen at the far right.

3. Then type the inner letter using the lowercase keys (a-z). This produces a white letter within a black circle.

4. If you'd prefer a black letter within a white circle, locate that using the chart below.

5. If you'd like to enclose the inner letter with a ring, type / between the letters.

6. If you want a larger ring that eliminates the white space between the outer and inner letters, type ? between the letters.

7. If you want the electron orbits, type those first using the < key.

8. If you're using a single large letter, you can fill it in with $_{\prime}$. or > instead of the lowercase letter.
