
NEEDLEPOINT MONOGRAMS v1.0



Set of 4 fonts to create monograms of 2, 3, 4 or more letters that look like hand-embroidered samplers, with a choice of styles and extras.

Install the fonts like any other and restart the application you want to use it in.

1. First, type a border, if desired. Here are the options, keystrokes in red.






Options for hexagonal, square, cross- and H-shaped 3-letter monograms; and rectangular 2-letter monograms. Some can be combined as shown to produce even more.

- 2. Type a small letter using lowercase (a–z).
- 3. Type a large letter using uppercase (A-Z).
- 4. Type a small letter using lowercase (a-z) and you're done.

For decorative touches above and below the small letters, type it before the letter.

To create a frame around a monogram of 4 or more letters, type the brackets and backslash before each letter.

There are 2 ampersands for A&B style monograms and alternates letterforms.
