

PHOTOSHOP USERS


- 1.) To use in Photoshop, simply double click on the OTF to install the Portabella Font Collection.
- 2.) Select Portabella SVG in your Character Panel and do your thing! It should type out just like any other font. :)
- 3.) If you'd like to change the color of your type, just double click on the layer that contains your text. This will bring up the Blending Options. Once you're in the Blending Options Panel, select: Color Overlay. Now you can sample or select any color you prefer.


ILLUSTRATOR USERS

- 1.) To use in Illustrator, you must make sure you're in the RGB color mode.

 FILE -> DOCUMENT COLOR MODE -> RGB
 - 2.) Select Portabella SVG in your Character Panel and do your thing!
- 3.) To adjust the color, you must first rasterize your type. **OBJECT -> RASTERIZE**Make sure RBG Color & Transparent Background are Selected.

 Once you do this, you can no longer change the text, so make sure your spelling is correct, and overall design is how you want it. :)
 - 4.) Go to **EDIT -> EDIT COLORS -> ADJUST COLOR BALANCE**Make sure Convert & Preview are checked.





5.) Now just use the sliders to adjust your color.
